## **Our Highest and Lowest Placement Scores by Central Placement**

According to the ÖSYS placement results announced by the Measurement, Selection and Placement Center Presidency in 2021, the students were placed in our department with the highest score of 217.32457, while the lowest score was 195.92020. All of the 25 student quotas opened in total have been filled. 20 students continue their education in our department.
